

Laboratory

Where Science meets Innovation

All the laboratories are well equipped as per the guidelines of Indian Nursing Council and spacious enough to accommodate our students.

FOUNDATIONS OF NURSING LAB: This laboratory is basically for first year students to develop skill in imparting basic nursing care to patients like meeting personal hygiene needs; elementary needs etc. and practising basic nursing procedures.

The lab has highly advanced mannequin and equipment's with special features to learn the basic nursing procedures. Special beds like fully fowler beds, Partial fowler beds, Adult beds, Paediatric bed, Air bed and Water beds. Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation can also be learnt on specialized mannequin.

PRE-CLINICAL LABORATORY: The pre-clinical

science laboratory is designed with the purpose of helping the students to acquire knowledge of the normal structure and functions of various human body systems and to identify any deviation from normal health in order to render effective nursing care. Preclinical Lab includes Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry and Microbiology Labs. The labs are well furnished so that students can acquire their knowledge through defferent demonstrations.

NUTRITION LAB: This lab is basically for first year students. It is like a mini kitchen and fully equipped with modern electronic gadgets like food processor, refrigerator and other utensils for practical demonstration of liquid, semi liquid, solid diet and develop the concept of special dietary requirements as per the disease conditions.

COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSING LAB: This Laboratory is utilized for Rural and Urban Health experience for Nursing Students. The Laboratory is well equipped with Performa for data



collection of individuals family & community, Performa for health assessment of infant, toddler, preschool, school going children, adult, geriatric age group & special groups like Antenatal, Intra-natal, Postnatal mother etc. family folder, referral etc. Community Health Nursing bags, health education material, charts, models, puppets are provided for training our aspiring nurses.

ADVANCED NURSING LAB: Advanced nursing skill lab has facilities like full body manikin, which is specifically designed for professional nursing training. These high quality manikin will provide a wide range of possible exercises including both first aid & emergency situations.

obg & PEDIATRIC LAB: This lab is utilized for experience in child health care. It is well equipped with neonate and infant mannequins. Specialized infant CPR mannequins assist students to develop skill to provide care in critical area. The paediatrics nursing skill and simulation laboratory is here to make the students clinical experience educational and enlightening and to promote empowerment of student. Scenarios and stimulation experiences relate to the paediatrics lab objectives. Students will be oriented to stimulation instructions prior to running a scenario.

Computer Lab

The state-of —the art computer centre provides plenty opportunities to students to get an exposure of IT environment and learn to use various tools and soware in their daily life and syllabi. Spacious Computer Laboratory with access to internet. Provision is made for computer education not only in 1st year but throughout the last year nursing course as an elective subject.

ANTI-RAGGING POLICY



The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Judgement The Supreme Court of India Order May 2007 (based on Raghavan Committee Recommendations)

We have perused the Report of the Committee constituted pursuant to thisCourt's order to suggest remedial measures to tackle with the problem of ragging in educational institutions.

An elaborate report has been submitted by the Committee headed by Dr.R.K. Raghavan. According to the Committee, the following factors need to be focused to tackle with the problem

- 1. Primary responsibility for curbing ragging rests with academic institutions themselves
- 2. Ragging adversely impacts the standards of higher education.
- 3. Incentives should be available to institutions for curbing the menace and there should be disincentives for failure to do so.
- 4. Enrolment in academic pursuits or a campus life should not immunize any adult citizen from penal provisions of the laws of the land.
- 5. Ragging needs to be perceived as failure to inculcate human values from the schooling stage.
- 6. Behavioural patterns among students, particularly potential 'raggers', need to be identified.
- 7. Measures against ragging must deter its recurrence.
- 8. Concerted action is required at the level of the school, higher educational institution, district administration, university, State and Central Governments to make any curb effective.
- I Media and the Civil Society should be involved in this exercise. The Committee has made several recommendations. For the present, we feel that the following recommendations should be implemented without any further lapse of time.

TIPS has strictly maintained a No-Tolerance attitude towards ragging and abide by the rules set by the Raghavan Commission According to the Supreme Court of India, it is a criminal offenceand in TIPS all the rules are strictly followed.

Complying with this definition of ragging, the following activities will be treated as an act of ragging:

- Abetment to ragging
- Criminal conspiracy of ragging
- Public nuisance during ragging
- Violation of decency during ragging
- Unlawful assembly while ragging
- Injury to body/Causing hurt
- Wrongful confinements
- Wrongful restraint
- Use of outsiders / Criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offence
- Extortion
- Criminal intimidation
- Physical or psychological humiliation
- Any act that prevents disrupts or disturbsacademic activity of a student.
- All other offences following from the definition of ragging

TIPS has an anti ragging committee to restrict such unlawful acts inside campus. This committee makes sure that no incident of ragging takes place in TIPS and exemplary punishment for the wrongdoers. Students can report any kind of ragging activity, incident of harassment or bullying to the committee. TIPS assure strict and fast action against raggers.

General Rules

- Selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of Common Entrance Test (CET) to be conducted by the institute/Tripura State Government nominate candidates from Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) conducted by Tripura Board of JEE.
- Institute's decision for the selection procedure in CET will be final, no complaint will be taken on that matter.
- 3. Student's enrolled are not permitted to undergo any other courses in other Universities/Institutes during the course tenure.
- Students will have to attend theory and practical classes as well as the training programmes with diligence and sincerity and will maintain discipline whatsoever during the course.
- Students will not be allowed to appear in the college exams and University exams unless he/she has attended 75% of the lectures, demonstrations and practical classes as per the University norms.
- Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the college will lead to disciplinary actions such as warning, fines and suspension or even expulsion from the college. In all disciplinary matters, the decision of the management will be final and binding.
- 7. The management of the college reserves the right to change/modify the prospectus, rules, guidelines, fee structures and other criteria of the college whenever necessary according to the situation and will not be answerable to anyone for such changes. Everyone connected to the college shall be bound by these rules and times. Any legal dispute, if arises shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of Tripura.
- 8. All students are required to carry the college identity card and should ware their uniforms within the campus during college hours. The identity card is issued by college after admission.
- All notices issued by the authorities of the college require mandatory reading and strict obedience.
- College fees should always be paid within the stipulated dates. However, after the due date,

- the fees may be paid with a late fee as detailed below:
- a) Late fee of Rs. 50 per day will be charged if not paid within due date. Last date of submission will be seven days prior to the examination date.
- b) Late fee for depositing hostel fees after due date is Rs. 25 per day. Last date of submission will be seven days prior to the examination date.
- c) Late fee for depositing other fees after due date is Rs. 25 per day. Last date of submission will be seven days prior to the examination date.
- 11. Students have to clear all the outstanding of the academic year within the stipulated time before the University/TNC examination schedule.
- 12. Semester examination fees, internal supplementary examination fees etc. will occur as directed by the college authority from time to time.
- 13. If library card, identity card or guardian visiting card for hostel are lost then the same can be obtained from the college office by paying a fee of Rs. 50/-.
- 14. Any fees once deposited will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 15. Students once admitted in the hostel will have to continue for one academic year.
- 16. Allocation of hostel facility will be completely under management discretion. Outstation students will be proffered first. Also, once allotted, every student has to abide by the rules and regulations of hostel as decided by the management.
- 17. Ragging or any activity of such indiscipline nature is strictly condemned by the authority. Any student found guilty in this regard would be punished accordingly by the authorities.
- 18. Minimum age limit for admission shall be 17 years for the fresh students.
